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Part one

Introduction

This livelihoods assessment was conducted as part of the LWR / Ana fi Aman Project in west Mosul.

West Mosul commune, is part of Mosul city belong to Nineveh province, it aims to contribute to the community and protection and empower their livelihood.

The assessment was led by the RNVD

Monitoring and evaluation department (M&E), and supported by staff from field office in Mosul.

The fieldwork component took place from 15 – 23 Mar 2018.

The need assessment is looking to identify the vulnerability and capacity of Mosul people.

These studies, rely on individuals' interviews models to collect information.

Locations:

The assessment conducted in different neighborhoods in west of Mosul which are (Nabi Sheet, Daowasa, Mansour, Al Akedad, Mosul Al Jadida, Wadi Hajar and Jousaq).

Methodology:

The assessment drew from individuals' interviews information sources, and the assessment looked on the livelihood condition and capacity needs for the people in Mosul, from what made us choose this methodology to be closely with people and their needs.

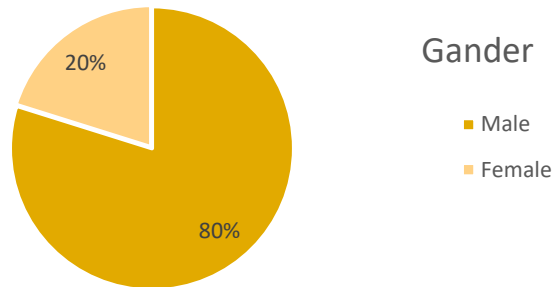
The questionnaire contained several kinds of question (closed, open, multi choosing and single choosing).

Part two: Samples details

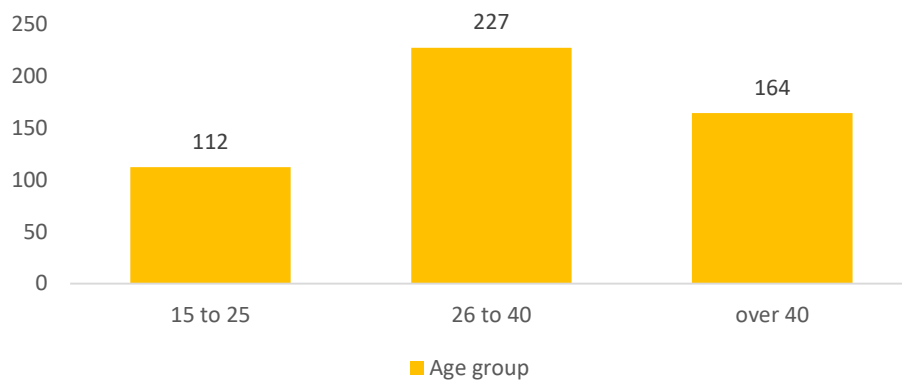
Numbers of interviews: 501 individuals

Gender of samples: as following pie:



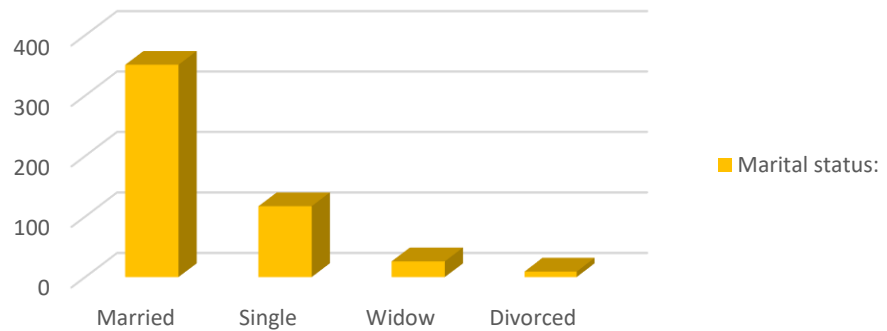
Samples age:

The data collectors worked to cover all the marital status and the result came as following chart



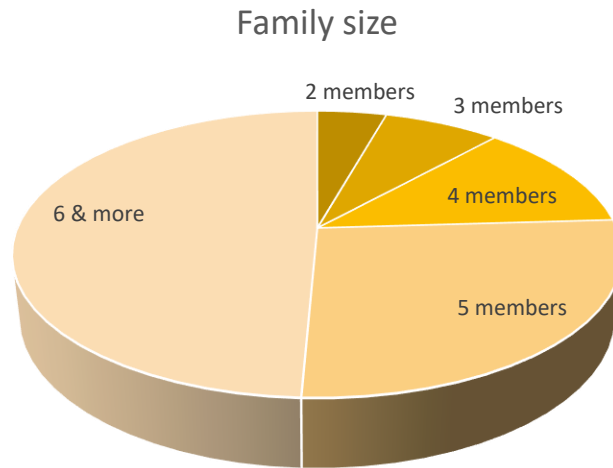
Education level

46% of samples are graduate from primary school,
35% of them are graduate from Secondary school,
Only 19% are graduate from university.

Family size (Members):

The following pie will give us clear idea
how big are the families in west Mosul?

*We can note 49% of families consists from
6 & more members and 27%
are consists from 5 members.*



Samples position

63% of them are household headers.

Part three: Outcomes of assessment

The first question in the survey was "Are you economically active?" the answer came 66% of the samples said yes we do, and 34% answer by negative.

50% of the 66% who answered by yes are working as free business, and followed with 10% are government employees, the rest distributed between daily basis worker, NGO staff, Military, Agriculture and industry.

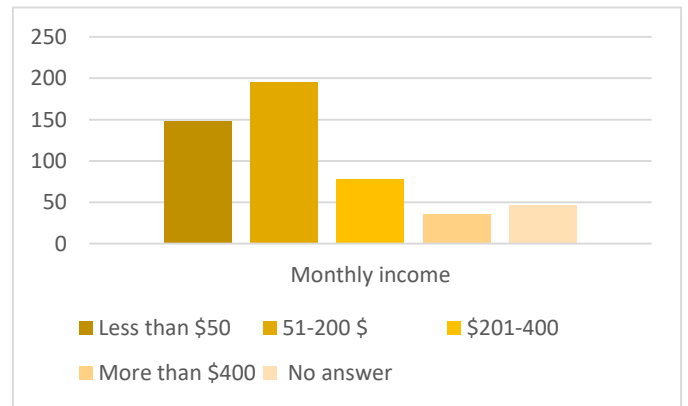
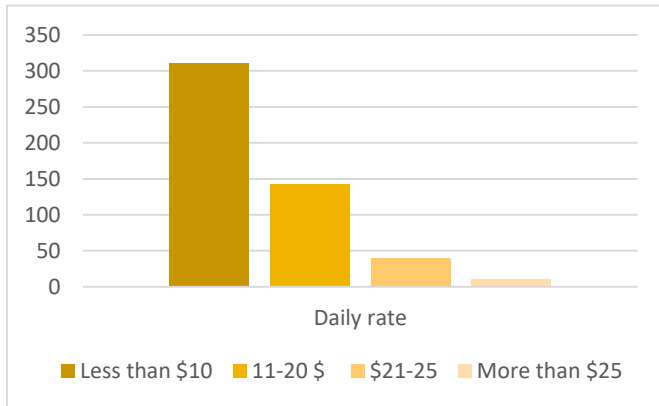
81% of families have one person have financial resource, 17% have two persons and 2% have more than 2 persons.

86% families are not able to save any money from their monthly income in west Mosul, but still 14% of the families have this ability for saving.

Nevertheless, 93% of families did not buy households furniture needed in the home within the last 12.

For the second financial resource only 5% of the families said yes we have other resource for income,

About the monthly income rate and daily rate, the next charts will be showing the samples answers:

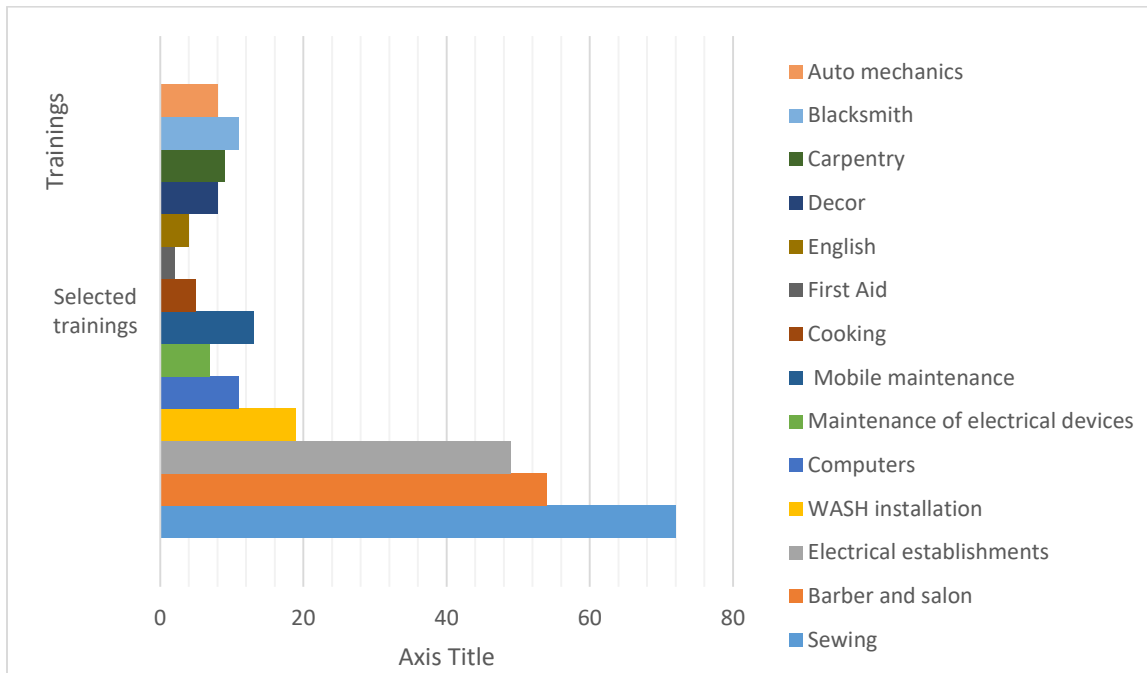


54% of the interviews said we do not have daily work.

We asked them if they have attended any community meetings or activities in last 6 months? 95% of them answered by No we did not.

85% of the people of west Mosul answered question about if there are need for vocational training centers in the city by with Yes we need for the vocational training in neighborhoods.
