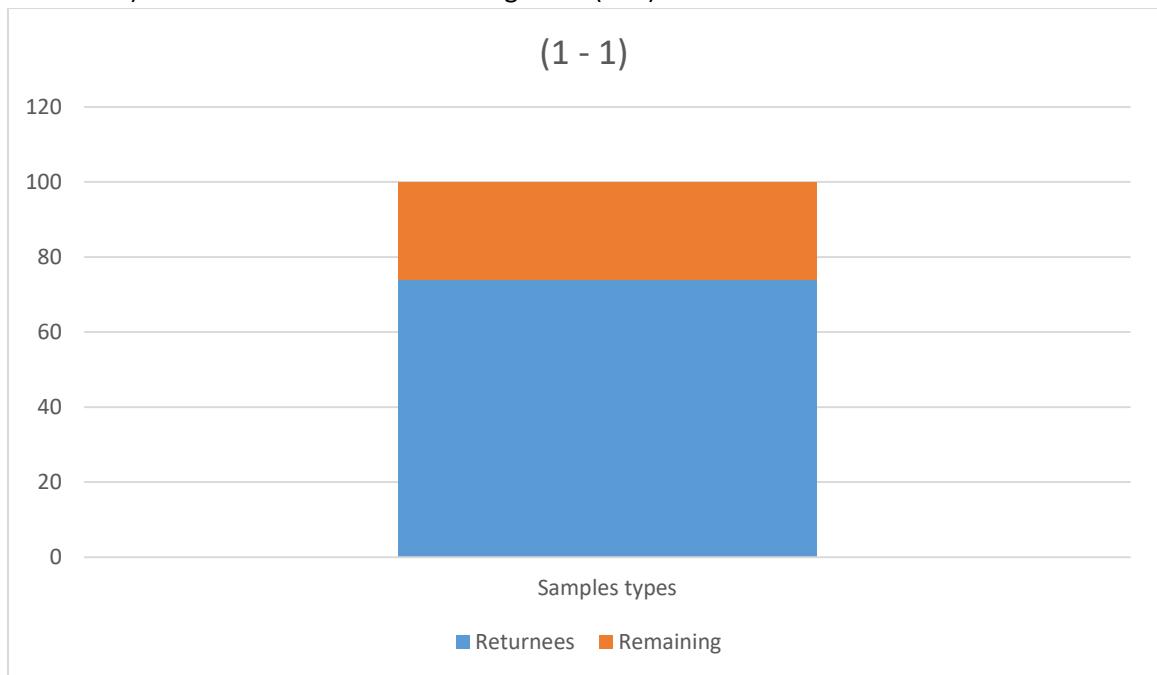


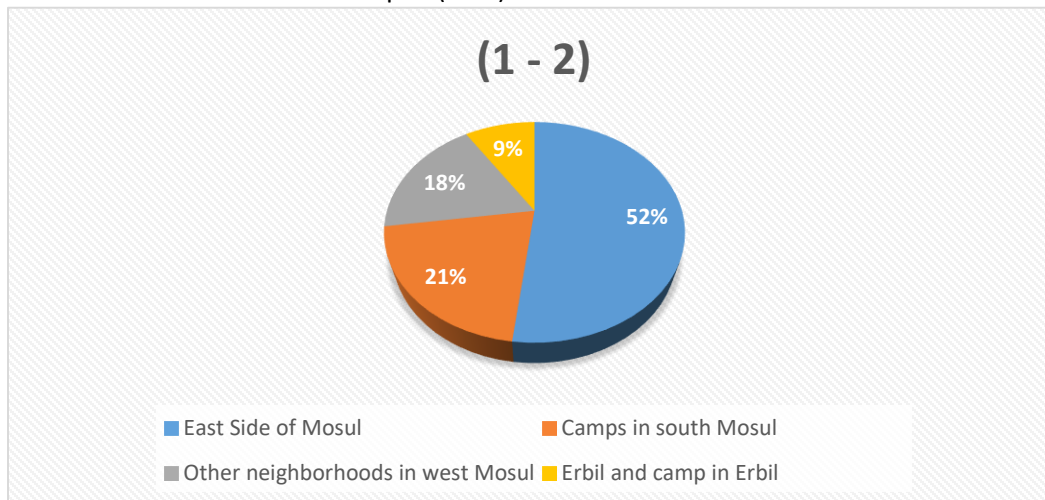
Need assessment / West side of Mosul

MEAL department in RONDPO launched Need assessment in West side of Mosul, the survey contained 45 question centered about the life condition in west side of Mosul and the challenges Samples details:

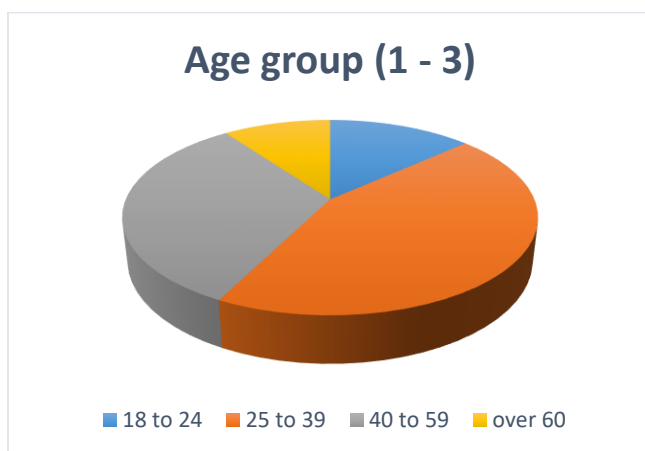
- Numbers of interviewer: 120
- Interview period: 8 Sept to 14 Sept 2017
- locations of survey, we conduct the assessment in most of west side of Mosul neighborhoods (Alrsala, Althoura, Dou Alsoukr, Aljousaq, Alzanjali, Alteran, Almansour, Alshafaa, Almamoon, Aldouasa, Alsha, Wadi Hajar, Alaakidat, Mousul Aljadida, Alghzlaini, Alyarmook, Alsmood, Tel Alroman and Alaamil)
- Gander of samples: we target in this survey both of ganders' relative ratios
 - Male 60%
 - Female 40 %
- Samples types: in our survey we put three choices for answering this question (IDPs, Remaining, Returnees). the answers came as following chart (1- 1)



- We asked the people who returning to West side of Mosul about the places of d bisplacement the answers were as the follow pie. (1 - 2)



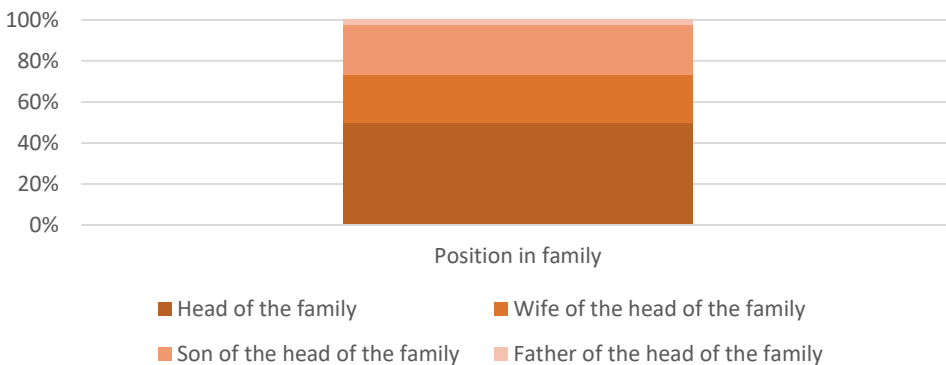
- Age group of the samples, in the following chart we will show to you the age group of Participants (1 - 3)



- Position of the samples from the families: 50 % of our samples are household head and 23 are Wife of the household head.

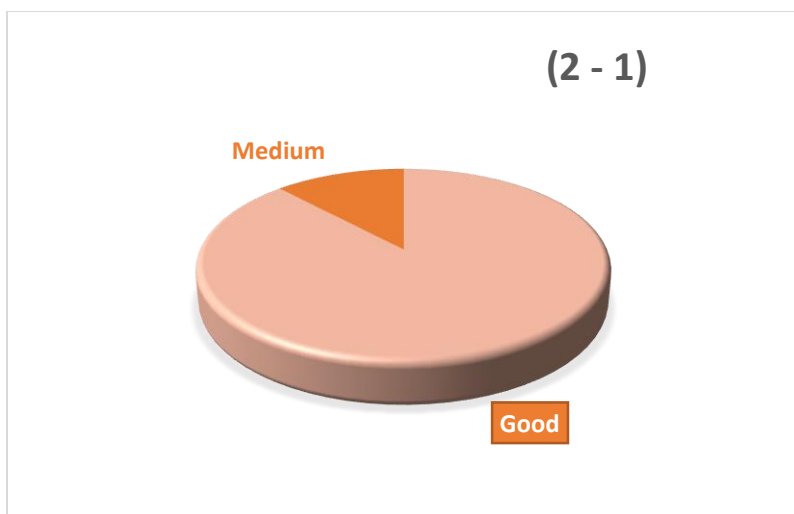

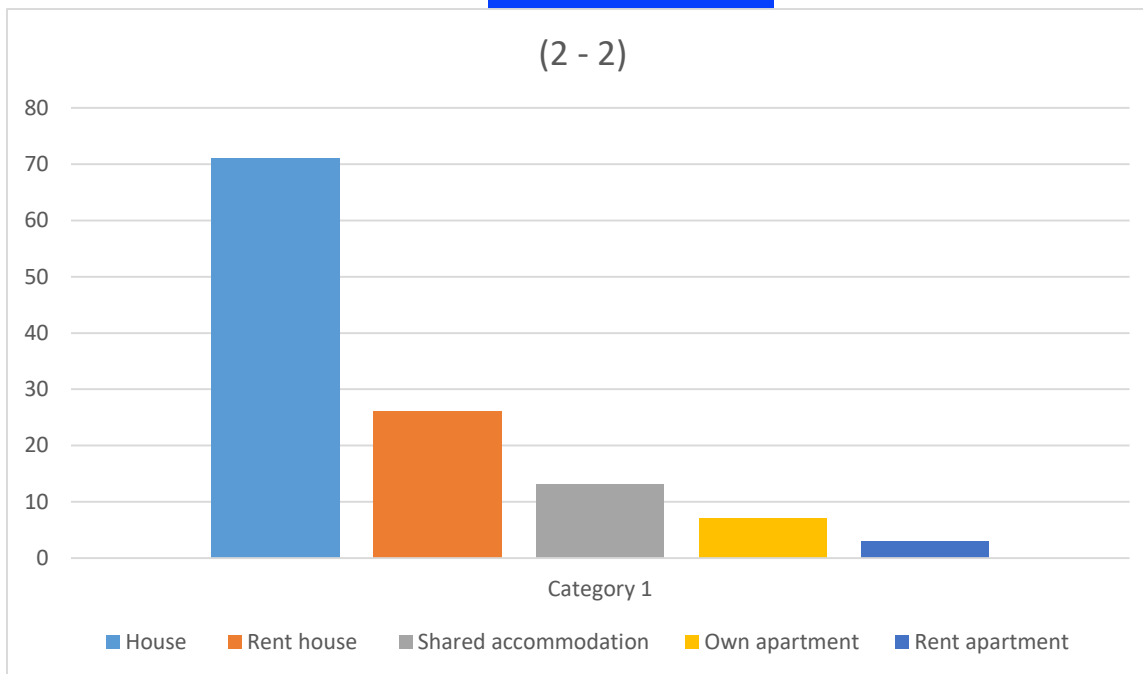


Finding and result of survey:

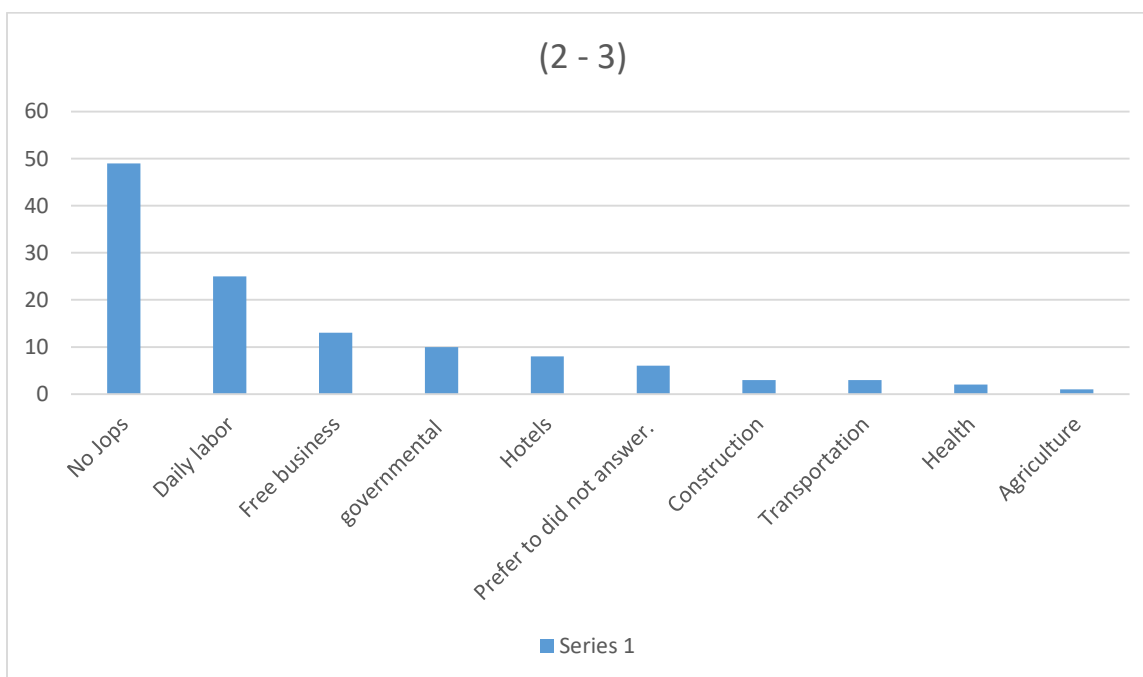
In first question about the security situation in current place? 88% said is good and /12% said is medium. the following chart showing us the answer as pie (2-1)



Part of our survey was about the kind of their accommodation, 59% said we own our houses, and 22% rents houses, the following chart will give us more details. (2 - 2)

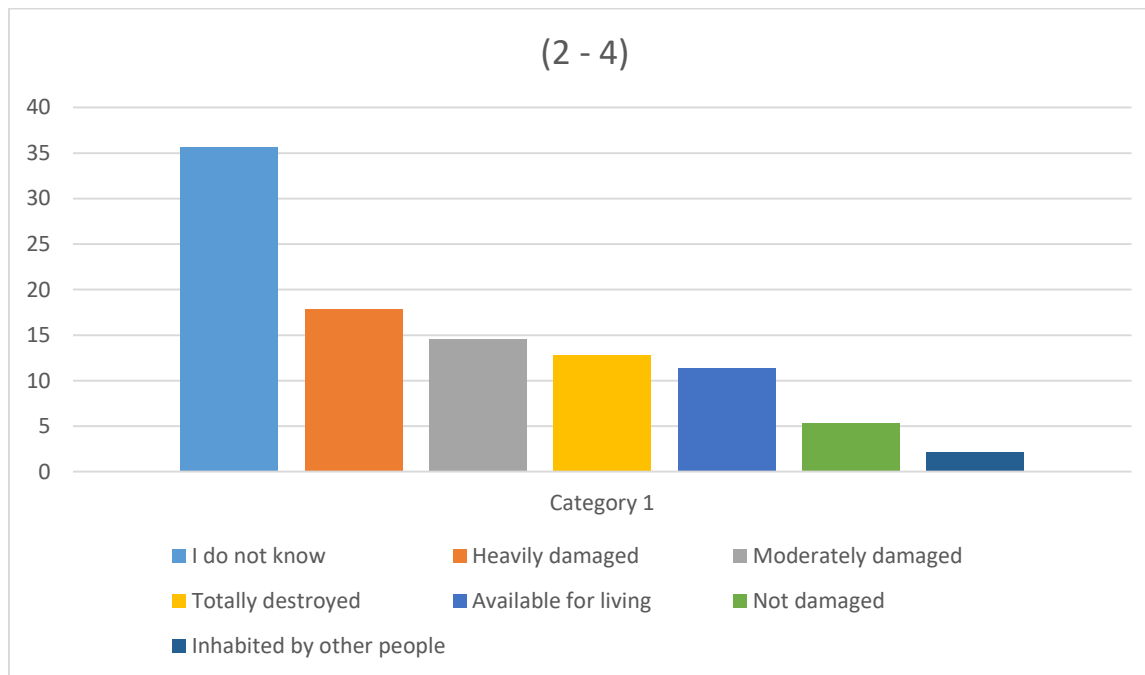


In other line in our survey we asked them what kind of jobs our samples have, the result came with 41% did not have jobs, and 21% daily labor, for more details we prepper following chart, (2 - 3)



It seems the people who return to their original area did get enough assistance according to our samples answers when they choice 80% negative to question if there are any assistance providing in liberated original areas, and 20% said yes there are assistance distributed there.

The house condition was the next indicator out from our survey that we launched, sounds the answers were difference, the following chart will tell us what our samples said. (2 - 4).

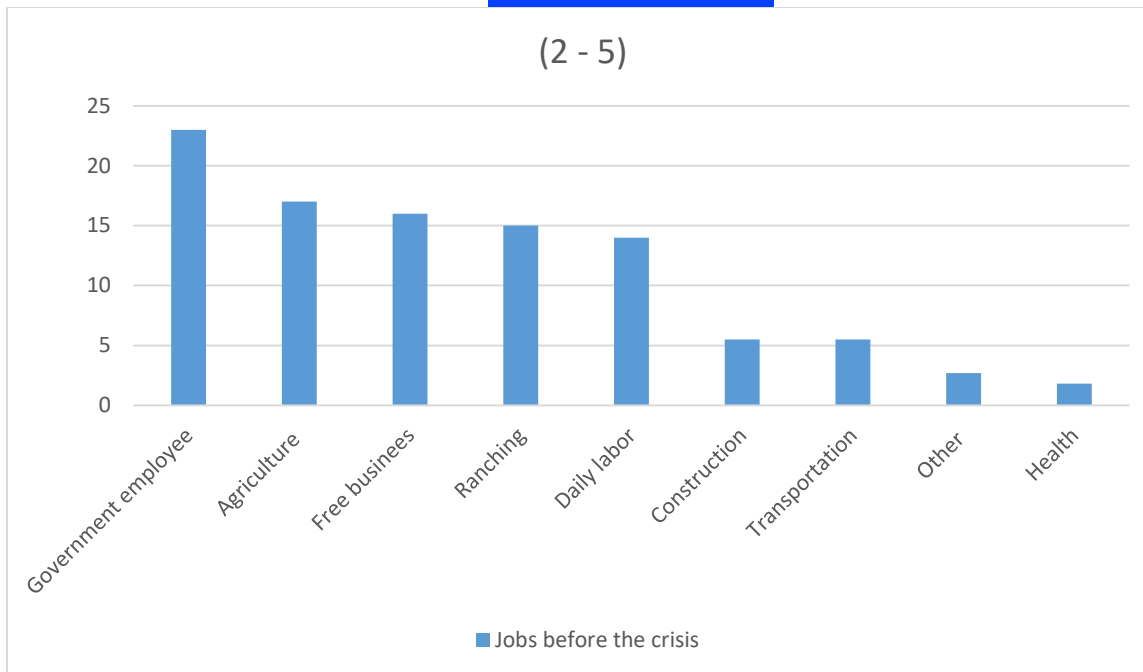


It is worth to mention that 86% of the samples they own houses in their original area.

About missing documents or the required documents for return 73% of them said we did not have any problem with this issues and we have all the documents. 27% of them answer with having problems with documents and does not have complete papers to return.

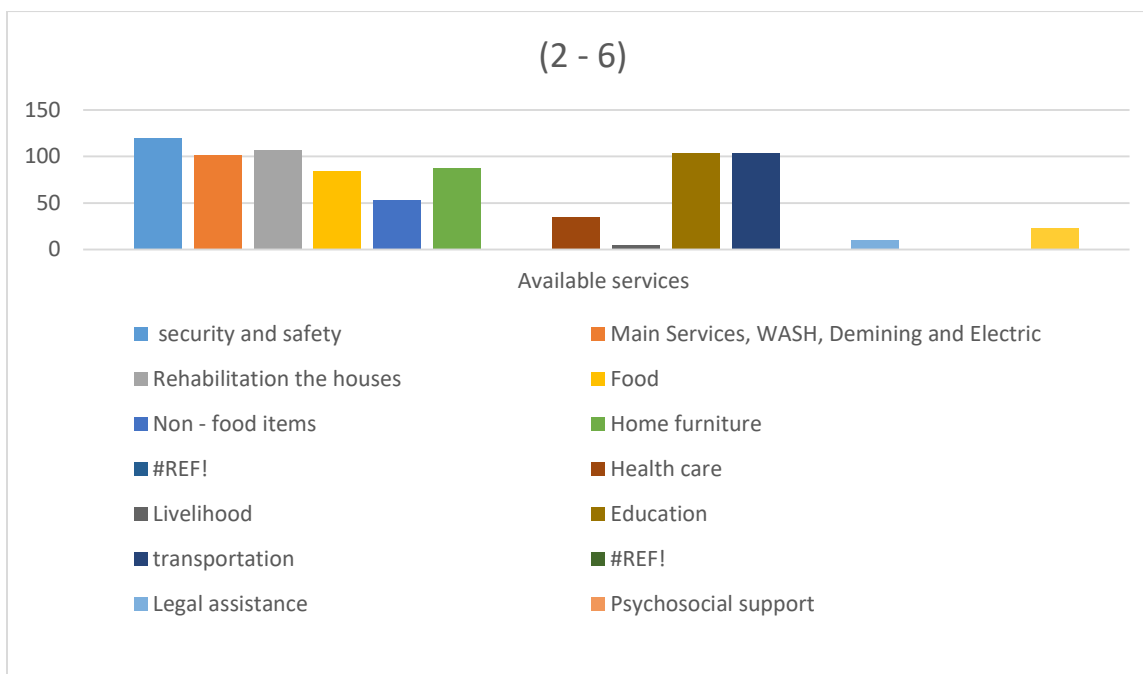
The interviewees being asked about their jobs before the crisis.

most answers were "government employee" in the rate of 23% and followed in agriculture in the rate of 18%, for more details kindly look at the below chart (2 - 5).



In related question about the salaries before the crisis most of answers were between 50 \$ to 200\$.

About the available services in city all of samples agreed the security is existing, in second place came rehabilitation the houses, then followed it transportation, kindly look the following chart which has more details. (2 - 6)



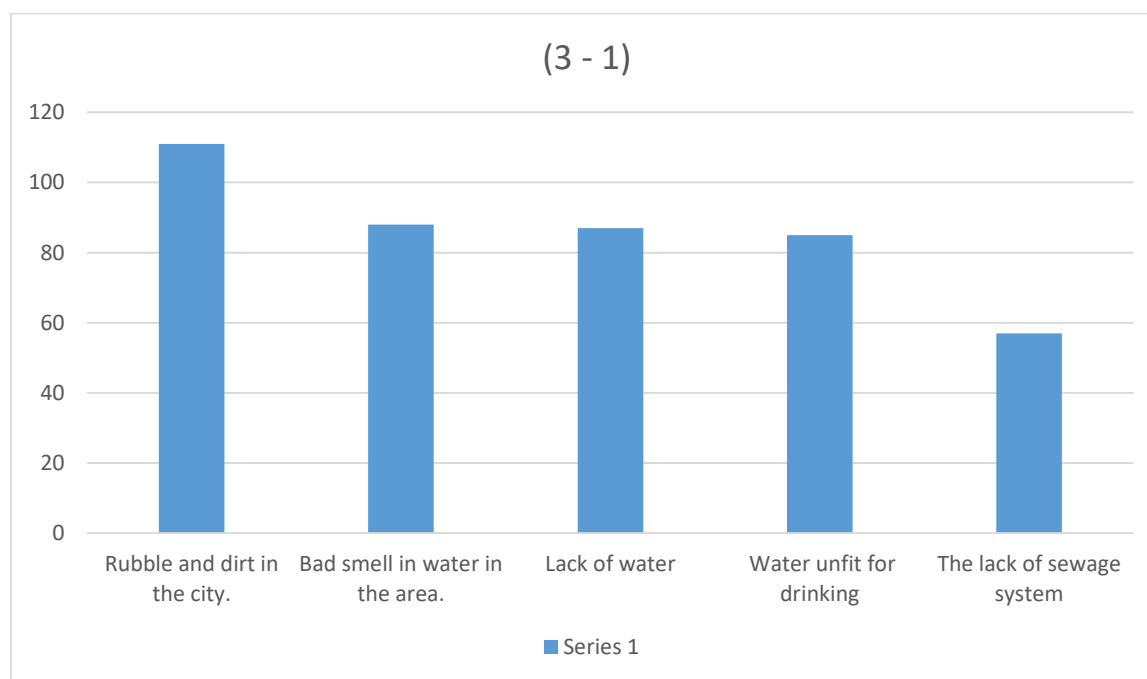
The protection issues have part of our survey the first question was about if there are specific concerns about women GBV & of the answers said more than 52% said Yes we do, and 44% No we did not, and 4% choice to say we do not know.

And if they have specific concerns about the elderly and the disabled 45% side Yes we do and 41 side we did not have but 14% side we do not know.

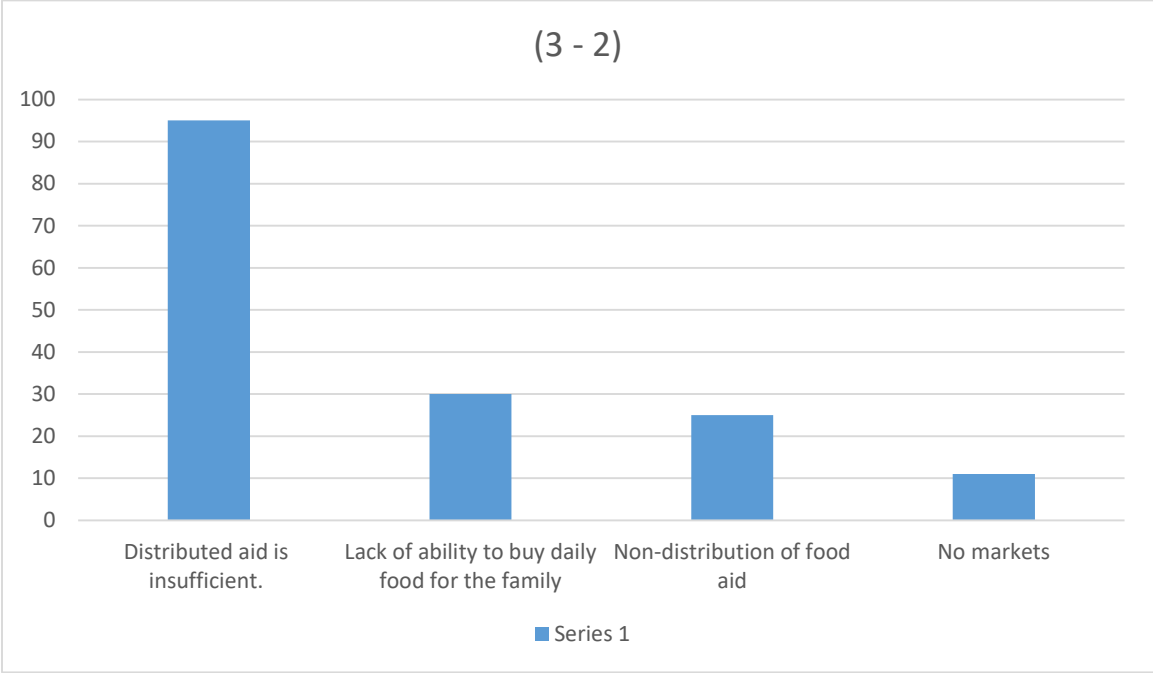
Samples shared with us their ideas and suggest some solutions for WASH problems in west side of Mosul, I am writing all their suggestion,

It is look the people in west side have many challenges in food security the next chart will give us best picture about the needs: (3 - 2)

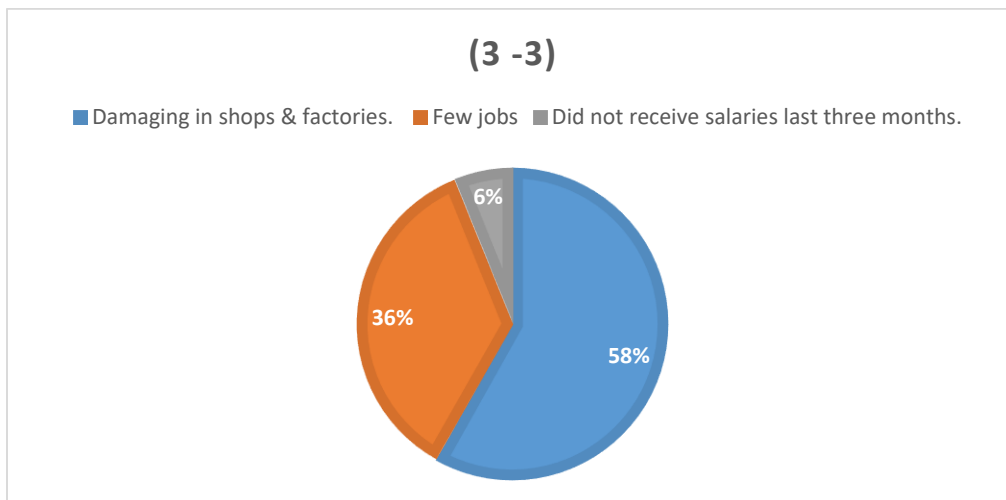


Suggest some solutions

The challenges of livelihood centered on three points. in the next pie will clear the points: (3 - 3)

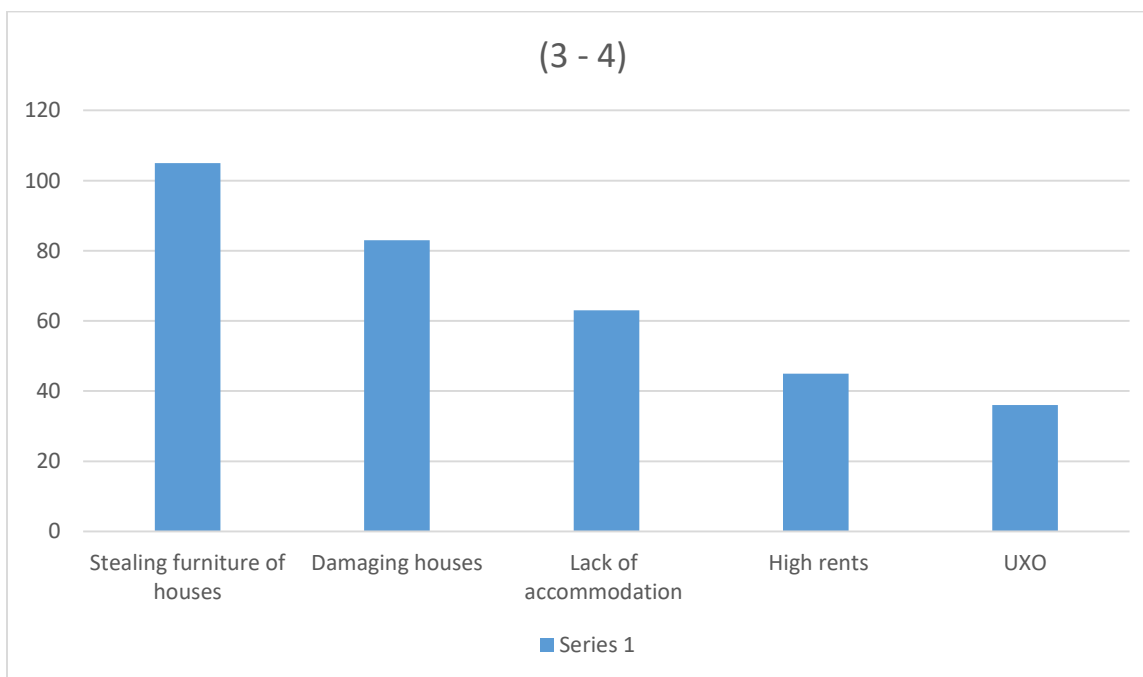


Suggest some solutions

- Operate factories to provide jobs.

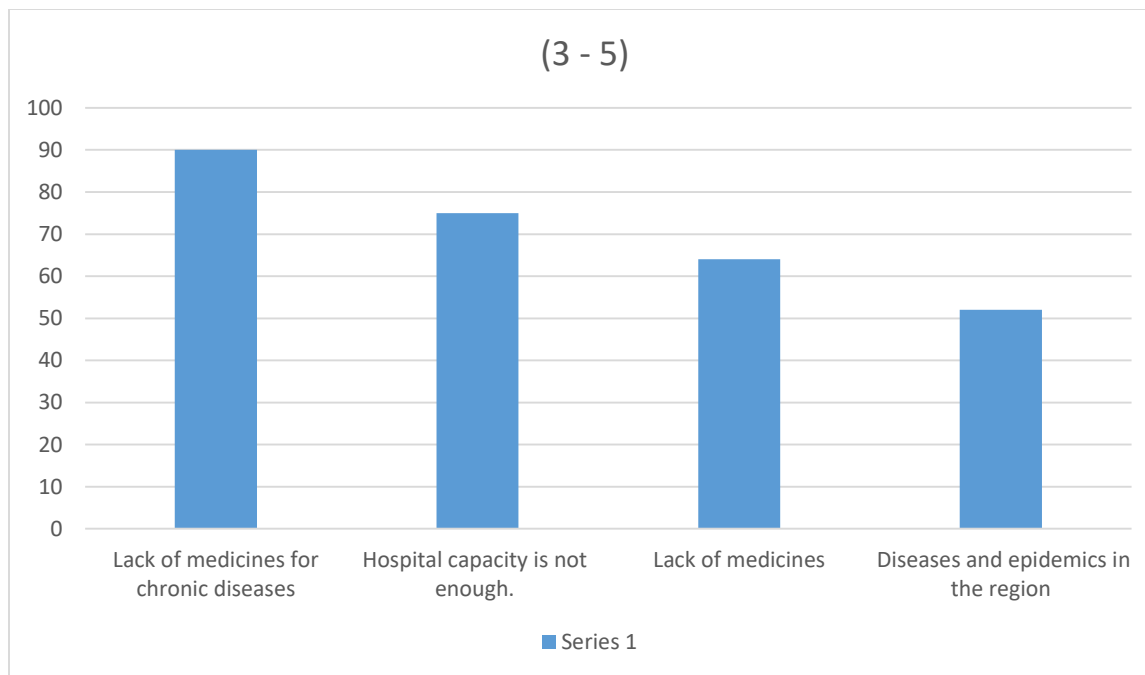
Shelter

Health

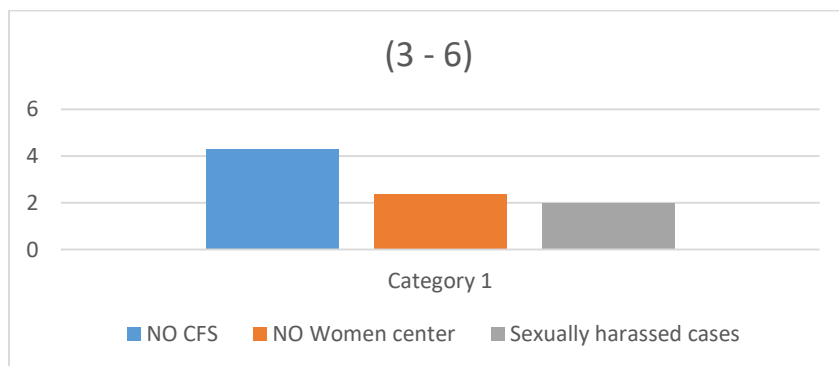
The challenges of Health centered on few points. in the next chart will clear the points: (3 - 5)
